here is no doubting that the Greeks had vision. In the 4th century they sailed into what they named Antipolis, the etymology of the name derived from "the opposite city", referring to Nice which already existed.

The Greeks stamped their settlement by building temples and monuments thereby leaving a strong cultural and artistic inheritance. The accumulated remnants of the antique Greek ruins enabled the Middle Age and the Renaissance to flourish and gave birth to the Chateau Grimaldi which is today the Picasso Museum. Not far from the coast, you'll see the Fort Carré which was originally built on an old Roman site. It became fundamental to the city and the port's protection against successive attacks over the centuries, namely the 1592 attack by the Duc d'Epernon, mandated by Henry IV to reconquer the city from the Duc de Savoie. Lets not forget the Austro - Sardis siege that lasted 57days. Louis XVIII, in recognition of their valiant resistance, honored the city by promoting it to the rank of "Bonne Ville".

Today Antibes is a living and beautifully maintained city with it's world renowned 'Cap' studded with luxurious villas and dissimulated beaches and bays, making it a favorite retreat of the 'Happy Few'.

Antibes is a 'must' as a holiday destination where you will enjoy your aperitif or dining on the terrace of the Hotel Belles Rives, where if you happen to be



there in July, you will hear some of the worlds most famous musicians play during the 'Juan-les-Pins Jazz Festival' . If you enjoy more symphonic music, then wonder on to the Villa Eilen Roc and bask in the wafting sounds of their concerts and operas.
